Science and Technology Platforms provide a form of structured interaction for different actors who have a shared interest in a scientific field and technological pursuits linked to the economy and society. The conference aims to explore the links between research, knowledge, technology, and innovation to discern the concrete implications for the European and Italian socio-economic systems.

The conference is promoted by Fondazione Edison and CRANEC, under the aegis of Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei and falls within the *Techno-science Platforms* (TSPs) and their reference networks. The case of Mind HumanTechnopole (M-HT) in Milan research project funded by Fondazione Cariplo.

The speakers are prestigious representatives from academia, foundations, research centres, the technoindustrial system and institutions.

The multidisciplinary approach emerges clearly from the titles of the sessions: Science and Technology Challenges; Platforms and their Governance; What Impact?; Platforms, Foundations and Industry; Networks and Nodes: from Infrastructure to Platforms; Problems, programmes and prospects for Italy in Europe.

Fondazione Edison published numerous books on these subjects both in Italian and English. Many are in fact the outcomes of conferences, alternatively edited by Alberto Quadrio Curzio and Marco Fortis. The first volume, Complexity and Industrial Clusters. Dynamics and models in theory and practice, was published in 2002. Over the past twenty years, close to a dozen books have been published on these and related themes

Ideally, the proceedings of this conference will be published both in Italian, as part of the Fondazione Edison series, and in English by Springer.
